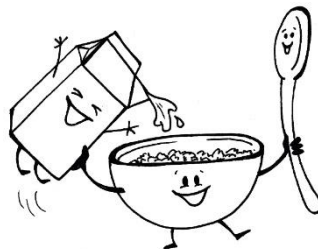

## Oakmeadow Breakfast Club



From the start of the new school year in September we are updating our breakfast club as follows:

### Opening times:

We will be opening earlier each morning – breakfast club will run from 7.50am until 8.55am each day. Access will continue to be via the after school club entrance and children will be registered on arrival. At the end of each session EYFS & KS1 children will be escorted to their classes by a member of staff.

### Food:

Our focus will be on healthy eating and a combination of the following will be on offer each morning:

- Fresh fruit
- A selection of healthy cereals
- Cheese or baked bean toasties
- Bagels
- Pancakes



- Crumpets
- Toast
- Low fat yoghurts

There will be at least 1 hot food option from the above available each morning and there will be a choice of water, milk or squash to drink.

### Booking and Charges:

The cost of each session will increase to £3.50 per day. You will continue to be able to book and pay for spaces in Breakfast Club online via School Money at [www.schoolmoney.co.uk](http://www.schoolmoney.co.uk) – if your child has not attended breakfast club during this school year please contact the school office in advance of when you would like them to attend, so that they may be added to the system.

### Activities:

There will be a range of activities for children to take part in daily, giving a choice throughout the week of indoor and outdoor sports, crafts puzzles, board games etc. Children may choose which activities they would like to take part in and there will always be the option of games etc. in the breakfast club room.

Monday	Ipads/laptops
Tuesday	Dancing/drama in the studio
Wednesday	Adventure playground
Thursday	Get creative (crafts)
Friday	Fun & games day (outside, weather permitting)

Above all breakfast club will continue to aim to provide children with a happy, safe environment before the school day begins. They will be able to enjoy a healthy breakfast each morning and choose from a range of activities throughout the week.
