To help us keep everyone safe, we ask that all children dismount from bikes and scooters as soon as they enter the school site. The only area where riding is permitted is around the track—not along the main straight path. If we continue to see children riding on site despite reminders, we will have to ask that bikes and scooters are not brought to school. Similarly at the end of the day please ensure children in the astro area are supervised and not running and jumping off the stage or sitting on the table tennis tables after being collected. We appreciate your support in helping us maintain a safe environment for all.

Thank you, as always, for your continued support. We hope the children thoroughly enjoy this exciting event—I am certain it will be a memorable day for everyone involved!
